## SEPTIC TANK TREATMENT SK3

SK3 is designed to maintain a healthy balance throughout the year. It reduces the demand for pumping out tanks, reduces blockages, removes foul odours and keeps pipes flowing freely.

SK3 contains a broad spectrum of selected bacteria in powder form that efficiently break down organic waste. Reducing sewage, fat, oil and grease to carbon dioxide and water.

### Usage:

To reactivate an existing tank and after cleaning: One 30gm sachet each day for four days.

Followed by a maintenance of one sachet per month.

### How to apply:

Drop one unopened sachet into the toilet bowl furthest from the Septic tank, wait until dissolved then flush.

SK3 is very effective, however performance will be reduced by the use of chemical cleaners such as bleach. Wherever possible use biodegradable detergents.
